Bournemouth Athletic Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the welfare of others. Therefore members are encouraged to be open at all times and share any concerns or complaints they may have about any aspect of the Club with the Welfare Officer (at June 2009, Wynne Munden).

As a member of Bournemouth Athletic Club you are expected to abide by the following code of practice for junior members:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background, religion, sexuality or physical characteristics
- Member should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions and inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late
- Members must wear suitable kit for training and matches, as agreed with their coach or team manager
- Members must pay fees due for membership, training ,matches or transport promptly
- Junior members may not smoke whilst at Kings Park or whilst representing the Club at competitions
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind at Kings Park or whilst representing the club at competitions
