## **URGENT NOTE FOR PARENTS RE WEDNESDAY DEVELOPMENT NIGHTS**

The first 10 week training block is due to start on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> October and, as previously advised, registration forms for the new format will be available at Kings Park next Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> September.

Since announcing the proposed changes and following the recent Olympics, there has been a surge of interest and a lot of children have signed up as members of the Club. In view of this, we anticipate that we are likely to reach the maximum number of 120 wishing to register. We also anticipate that the vast majority of these will be paid up members of the Club, who will as previously indicated take priority over non-members.

We are, therefore, strongly recommending that all parents/guardians wishing to register their child/children attend next Wednesday to enable you to stand the best chance of securing a place/places for the first 10 week block.

As we are expecting the registration period to be very busy, we are setting out the following procedure to ensure it all runs as smoothly as possible.

Parents/children will be required to register for that evening session in the café area as usual.

Registration Forms and accompanying literature relating to Codes of Conduct will be handed out at this time and tables and pens will be available for parents/guardians to complete the forms in the café area.

We will be setting up a registration area in the 'official's room' which is adjacent to the café and this can be accessed via an internal door. Our Membership Secretary, Dave Parsons will be there to scrutinise the forms and check on membership criteria. He will also be able to answer any membership queries and take any new forms being handed in with the appropriate payment.

He will then direct parents/guardians to other members of our Admin team for them to record the registration and record them on our new lists. This will enable us to keep a close eye on the numbers being registered. We will require the completed registration form together with payment for the first block i.e. £20 for members. We hope to be able to confirm acceptance for the members who register on that night. For any non-members, we will accept the registration form but not take any payment as we will not be able to confirm inclusion for the first block immediately.

We ask that everyone bears with us during this initial period as we transfer to the new format.
